



TERM OF AGREEMENT

GENERAL CONDITIONS¹:

The institution above agrees to participate in the following activities of the project:

- 1) To do interdisciplinary activities and collaborative music and video creation using Soundcool system with their students which include performative projects, video installations and concerts.
 - a) Compositions about the city (January and February 2016). Record a video and uploaded to the platform.
 - b) Compositions about poetry, stories or national writers (march, April 2016). Record a video and uploaded to the platform.
 - c) Compositions about graphic scores and nature (October, November, December 2016)

3) To select the students for the mobility according to clear, fair and transparent criteria established in the project.

- a) Music grades

- e) Stay in the school the 2 years of the duration of the Project
- f) Alcàsser (11 years old); Carcaixent (14-16 years old); Romania (12-14 years old); Portugal (11-12 years old); Italy Messina (11-14 years old); Club Salvatore (14-16 years old)

4) To contract a health insurance policy for traveling teachers and students

5) To participate in all transnational meetings (Romania, end of September, 2016, 1 teacher of each institution; Portugal, 1st week of June, 2017, 2 teachers of each institution)

6) To participate in the DVD recording and to have legal authorization of the families of the students to record them.

7) To upload the videos created to the Soundcool platform <http://soundcool.org/> Respecting the deadlines.

8) To send a power point presentation about your institution (in English) to the coordinator in order to disseminate the project in other partners websites and on the Soundcool platform (February 2016).

9) To Translate the Soundcool guide into your national language (37 pages)

10) To send the assessment form from each transnational meeting and teaching-learning activities (student mobility).

11) To provide all the information to fulfilment of the intermediate and final project.

12) To disseminate the project and the project activities at your website. Put the information of the Erasmus+ Project with the names and information of all institutions, logos and a link to the Soundcool platform on your website.

13) To have a specific place on each institution building to display pictures and information about this Project.

14) To participate in the international study (to translate and give to the students the questionnaire)

COMUNICATION PROCEDURES:

The institution agrees:

- 1) To communicate periodically with the project coordinator at elicarras@hotmail.com or What Sapp 696704865, to inform the development of the project, at least once every two weeks. Please, we allow 48h limit to answer emails.
- 2) To access the files at the Dropbox folder
- 3) To do specific meetings via Skype
- 4) To communicate any problem or doubt to the project coordinator as soon as it occurs.

ECONOMICAL CONDITIONS:

We have received 80% of the budget as a pre-funding (81.976,00 euros), in order to keep the money and obtain the other 20% all the partners need to accomplish all the activities in the project. Otherwise our National Agency will ask us to reimburse the money. This amount is exclusively for the project activities and there will be no benefit for any of the institution (all the budget must be spent in project activities).

The institution agrees:

- 1) To spend the pre- funding money only with the project activities.
- 2) To send a copy of all the bills of the expenses of the project scanned by email or Dropbox to the coordinator and to keep the originals for 5 years at your institution.
- 3) The institution will receive the first payment after signing this agreement. In the first payment the institution will receive:
 - a. 600 euros to buy tablets
 - b. 275 euros for each student for traveling expenses (360 for Romania), to buy 5 tickets for the first teaching-learning activity in Sicily.
 - c. The individual support for the students mobility (275 euros per student) will be send to the Italian partners who will be responsible to provide the lodging and maintenance of the students.
 - d. 500 euros Individual support for one teacher
- 4) The institution will receive the budget for transnational meetings (575 per person for Italy, Portugal and Spain and 760 per person for Romania) and teaching-learning activities before each event.
- 5) The organizational support (6000 euros for each partner for project management) will be distributing according the following:
 - To pay for the extra expenses out of the budget for all the transnational meetings (see current budget excel file Annex 2)
 - To pay for the construction and maintenance of the collaborative website (guides, videos, tutorials, etc.) www.soudncoool.org. Org, (1000 euros of each partner)
 - We will safe part of this grant in case any partner needs special training courses in their country.

FIRST STUDENT MOBILITY:

Location: Messina, Italy

Date: approx. 14- 19 May

Duration of activity: 5 days

The first mobility student activity will be held in Italy. During five days in May 2016 four students from each organization will have the opportunity to collaborate in the realization of a common project: The sounds of the city. Partners will present a video with their compositions created during the previous months. During the 5 days of work students will develop musical activities of sound recording, manipulation and musical composition on the theme of nature with the aim of working together with students from other countries and cultural environments and perform in a concert. Students will have the opportunity to meet other cultural aspects of visiting Italy, concerts and other educational and cultural activities.
